# OUR VALUES

In 1955, the College of Home and Social Sciences was established as an affiliated college of the University of the Punjab with the efforts of Begum Rana Liaqat Ali Khan and the Education Department, Pakistan. Ford Foundation, USA also assisted by providing advisors and scholarships for teachers' training in the field of Home Economics in the United States. The college had a partnership with Oklahoma University, USA to assist in curricula development and teachers' training. From 1955 to 1960, the college offered B.Sc., M.Sc., B.Ed., and CT programs. In 1968, the name was changed to College of Home Economics.

Government of the Punjab reconstituted Government College of Home Economics as University of Home Economics Lahore on 19<sup>th</sup> April, 2017. College of Home Economics and Social Sciences has been established as constituent college of University of Home Economics Lahore on 18<sup>th</sup> June, 2021 to continue its legacy of providing quality education.



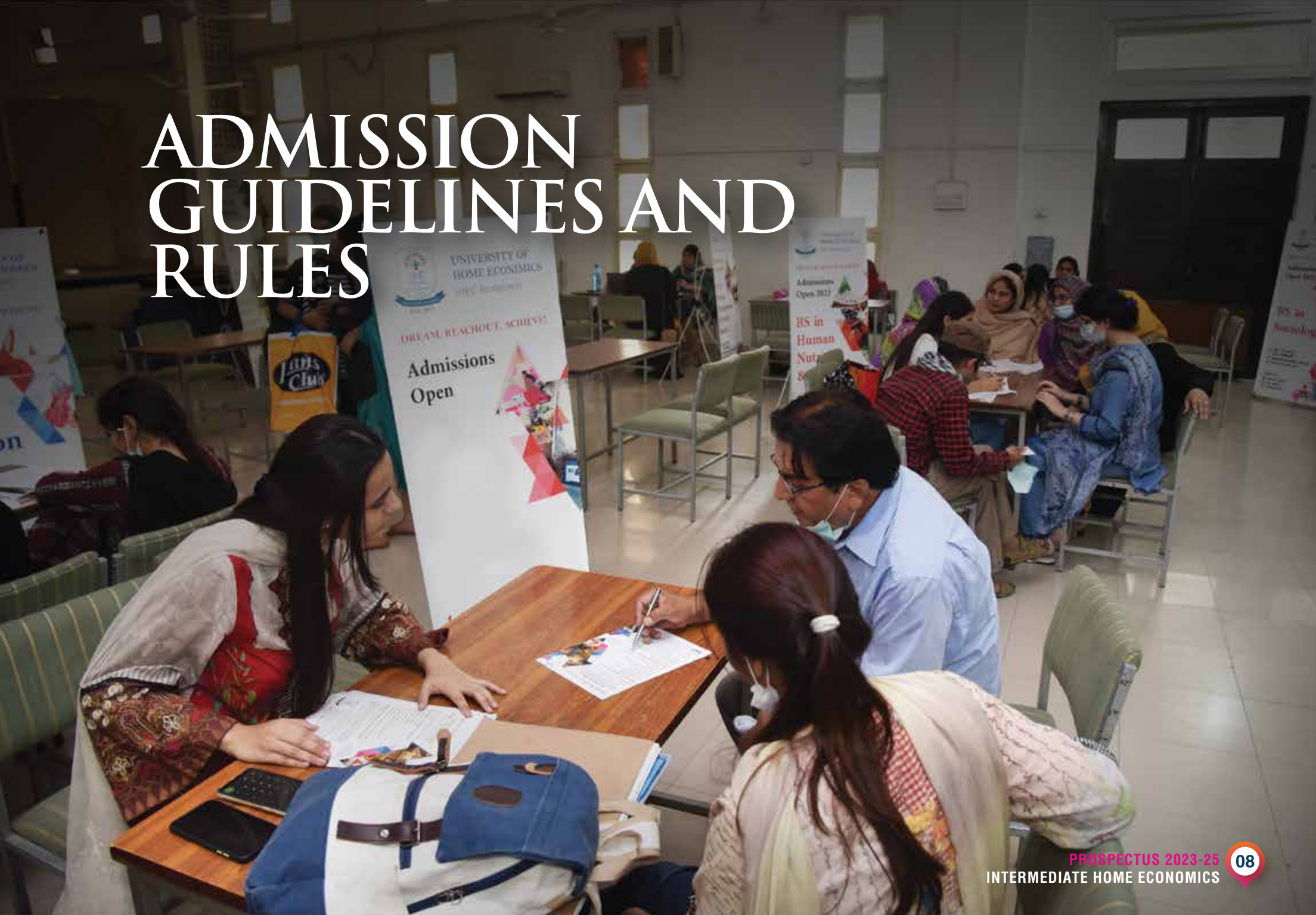

# ADMISSION GUIDELINES AND RULES





- Applicants with a minimum of **45% marks** in SSC (Matric/O-Level) are eligible to apply
- The Admission Form & Application Processing Fee Challan can be downloaded from the University website <https://uhe.edu.pk/chess/>
- Applicant must submit separate admission forms duly filled for each category (i.e., Open Merit & Reserved Seats) along-with original fee challan.
- Applicants holding Hifz-e-Quran certificate will be given 20 additional marks on passing the test
- The name of the program i.e., Intermediate Home Economics must be written on top left corner of Envelope
- Complete form with all attested documents should reach Office of the Principal not later than **12<sup>th</sup> September, 2022**, via courier/registered post at the following address:

## RESERVED SEATS

### Important Notes for Applicants:

- Applicants who have participated in Inter-school, District, Provincial or National Sports, Qirat, Naat, Debates, Drama and Singing competitions or can play a musical instrument are eligible for admission on the basis of extra-curricular activities. The applicant must provide copies of certificates indicating the same.
- Foreign applicants will come through the Federal Ministry of Education, Government of Pakistan or Higher Education Commission Islamabad.
- Overseas Pakistani applicants will submit their foreign qualification certificate as an evidence along with their NICOP or any of the parents.
- Female Transgender applicants must submit their NADRA registered certificate along with medical report of UHE doctor.
- For the daughter of the martyr, death certificate attested by the concerned department must be attached.
- Applicants of religious minority must provide supporting documents.
- Disabled applicants must submit their disability certificates from Social Welfare and Bait-ul-Maal Department, medical reports and any other relevant documents.
- Applicants from Baluchistan, Sindh, KPK, Gilgit Baltistan and Azad Jammu Kashmir must submit their nominations through the concerned Provincial Government along with the domicile certificate.

## Three (03) sets of attested photocopies of following documents must attach with the Application Form

- ✓ Matriculation/O Level/Equivalent Certificate
- ✓ Character Certificate issued by the Head of the Institution last attended
- ✓ Passport-size photographs with white background
- ✓ “B” Form/CNIC of applicant
- ✓ CNIC of Father/Guardian
- ✓ Original Migration Certificate from the concerned Board (except Lahore Board)
- ✓ In case of reserved seats, relevant certificates / supporting documents

## Important Notes for Applicants:

- All above documents in original, of the admitted students, shall be examined at the time of depositing the dues.
- Incomplete applications shall not be entertained.
- In case of any discrepancy found in application, Admission shall be cancelled.

# DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

- Merit Lists of the selected candidates will be placed on the University of Home Economics website and College Notice Board
- Fee Challan will be downloaded from University Website
- Yearly dues will be charged at the time of Admission.
- To secure admission, all dues must be deposited within the prescribed dates.
- The admission will be cancelled, if dues are not deposited by the due date. Vacant seats will be filled by the candidates on the waiting list. However, special permission by the Admission Committee may be granted in case of the availability of vacant seats.

**Note:**

- **All information regarding merit lists, fee deposit dates, date of commencement of classes and other related information will be announced and regularly updated by the University Authorities on the website.**

# PAYMENT OF DUES

- 100% tuition fee concession will be given to the Hafiz-e-Quran applicants.
- 100% tuition fee concession will be given to the Top-3 position holders of BISE, Lahore.
- 50% tuition fee concession will be given to the 4<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> position holders respectively in matriculation results of BISE, Lahore.
- 50% tuition fee concession will be given on a kinship basis to one of the real sisters of a regular student of UHE.

# LIFE AT CAMPUS

We are focused on education that is not just confined to the classroom. On our 17 Acres campus, surrounded by lush green lawns and old trees, the campus houses a large playground, auditorium, library, seminar and conference halls besides academic blocks.

We stand for inclusion, tolerance and diversity. The faculty, staff and administration aim to nurture an environment that provides equal opportunities to our students to shine and excel. Our focus is on promoting tolerance, equality, and diversity while fostering an environment of inter-cultural and inter-religious harmony and mutual respect.



Attending an orientation session is mandatory for students. Names of students, who remain absent from classes without intimation to the Principal's Office for a period of 15 Days, will be struck off.

Identity cards will be issued to the students to carry while at campus and produce on demand. Otherwise, they will have to pay Rs.100 as a fine. In case of a card being lost a duplicate card will be issued for Rs. 400 Parent/Teacher meeting will be held in the first week of February.

No student will be allowed to sit in a higher examination without clearing the lower year examination.

As the Intermediate courses are of specialized nature, the students are required, students are required to maintain a minimum of 75% attendance to be eligible for the Final Examination.

The students who take a break during Intermediate Program for a valid reason may resume studies within a period of three years. They shall be readmitted only if the same scheme of studies is in practice. This concession is valid only once in the whole Intermediate Program. Such students shall take the examination in the same Syllabus enforced at that time.

# CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE

The students of Intermediate ( Part 1 and Part 2) shall strictly follow uniform rules. However, they may choose to wear colored clothes on Fridays, if they wish so. The uniform follows as:

- White cotton shalwar and shirt with sleeves and collar  
Turquoise dupatta Scarves, if worn, should be plain black, white, gray or light pink.
- Turquoise blazer decked with University crest is an essential part of winter uniform.
- Plain black sweaters without any stripes or pattern  
White socks, Black shoes or black joggers.
- Wearing overalls is mandatory for every student during practical classes.
- We highly appreciate parent's co-operation with the University Authorities in maintaining simplicity, neatness and modesty regarding their girl's dress.

Learning is no longer restricted to classrooms and to give students a holistic experience, the Institution provides them with the opportunities to discover and channelize their unique talents.

A number of clubs and societies organize activities, events, competitions, productions, seminars, conferences and more.
