



The journey spans more than half a century since 1955 when the untiring efforts of Begum Rana Liaqat Ali and the Education Department bore fruit and the College of Home and Social Sciences was established.

Ford Foundation, USA helped in its development by providing advisors and scholarships for teachers' training in the USA. The College also had a partnership with Oklahoma University, USA to assist in the development of curriculum and teachers' training. The name was changed to College of Home Economics in 1968. All Pakistan Home Economics Association was registered in 1961.

The Act of the University of Home Economics was passed by the Punjab Assembly on 8th February 2017 thus upgrading this prestigious institution with even higher aims. Prof. Dr. Kanwal Ameen took the charge as the founding Vice-Chancellor of the University on 31st May 2019. This transition from a College to a University was not an easy journey, but her progressive vision, proactive leadership, diverse experience, focused attitude, passion and unremitting efforts have made this enormous task smooth. Consequently, the University has grown in a swift manner.

Within a short span of time. The infrastructure including labs, library, various academic and administrative blocks have been upgraded and renovated whereas the construction of a new Academic Block is in speedy progress.














Library

The three-floor University Library aims to connect students, faculty, and researchers with information resources in both printed and digital forms. The ground floor houses more than 11,000 printed books and journals/magazines related to the various disciplines offered at the university. In addition to textbooks, the library has a good collection of fiction/ non-fiction, biographies, travelogues, and other reading materials to encourage the readership. Moreover, the library provides the access to digital material including teacher's resources, interactive videos, and various presentations to enhance the teaching and learning experiences. Recently a mobile app is developed to facilitate users.

The Digital Resource Centre on the 1st newly furnished floor provides access to thousands of E-books, research journals and theses through HEC digital library access. It comprises basic databases including OVID, ASTM, INFORMS, ProQuest thesis, SpringerLink, Wiley, and Taylor and Francis Journals. Along with these, the library facilitates the researchers by connecting them to a range of open access resources including the Directory of Open Access Journals and the Directory of Open Access Books.



Scholars Corner

The 1st floor of the library provides a quiet and peaceful corner for the students' scholarly works. The facility is supported with carrels desks, highspeed internet, and charging points.







Reading Discussion Hall

The Reading and Discussion Hall on the 2nd floor of the library facilitates the discussion and other activities such as group study, reading, and tutorials to promote collaborative learning. The library halls are fully airconditioned and are equipped with internet facilities. The floor is wellfurnished, with comfortable seating arrangements.

Cafeteria



BS Fashion Design

The Fashion Design degree nurtures the connection between the industry and creativity. We focus on the skills and knowledge to excel in the fashion industry and prepare our students to become the future faces of fashion. Our labs are equipped with the latest machinery that provide a facilitating environment for growth. Traditional pattern-making and draping techniques are taught alongside digital design software to give students fashion design skills in conformity with international standards. Our experienced faculty encourages students' creativity to experiment with designs, materials, and garment-making to develop their individual creative approaches.



Degree holders can become Fashion Consultant, Fashion Stylist, Costume designer, Fashion Illustrator, Fashion designers, Visual merchandiser, Merchandiser, Costume stylist, Personal stylist, Fashion Blogger, Fashion publicist (PR), Fashion curator, and Product promoters.



Eligibility

The candidate holding an Intermediate Certificate with a minimum of 50% marks is eligible to apply. Entry tests and interviews are compulsory with 50% passing marks in each category. The merit will be based on the cumulative scores of intermediate, test and interview.

BS Fine Arts

The program comprises primary and supporting disciplines in Fine Arts. It teaches the students to study, explore and master different techniques and mediums of drawing, painting, printmaking, calligraphy and other skills. Students would learn to become professional artists. The program will familiarize the students with the historical contexts of different movements in Arts and relate, compare and contrast the major painting styles that emerged in art traditions. The program aims to enable the students to emerge as skilful artists with the ability to translate research into practice, develop contemporary artistic skills, and use their imagination and observation to create innovative works of art.





The candidate holding an Intermediate Certificate with a minimum of 50% marks is eligible to apply. Entry tests and interviews are compulsory with 50% passing marks in each category. The merit will be based on the cumulative scores of intermediate, test and interview.



Employability

Students with this degree can find their way into the practical field as painters, designers, art historians, art critics, teachers, art researchers, and entrepreneurs. They can find jobs with educational institutes, art galleries, museums, and governmental and semi-government organizations.



BS Interior Design

BS Interior Design focuses on identifying environmental issues and developing systems to rectify these issues. Another dimension of this program is to produce academicians and researchers in the field of interior design. The comprehensive and intensive curriculum will enable students to turn into professionals seeking innovative and socially responsible design solutions. We also provide an academic platform for research in the field of interior design.



The course is designed to produce skilful personnel in all areas of Interior Design like furniture, furnishings, and lighting etc. Another dimension of this program is to produce academicians and researchers in the field of interior design.



Eligibility

The candidate holding an Intermediate Certificate with a minimum of 50% marks is eligible to apply. Entry tests and interviews are compulsory with 50% passing marks in each category. The merit will be based on the cumulative scores of intermediate, test and interview.

BS Ceramic Sculpture Design

The program aims to develop the technical skills and aesthetics needed to be professional ceramists and sculptors. The course draws on multiple teaching approaches i.e., lectures, workshops, field trips, seminars, tutorials, and group discussions through audiovisual aids. It carries hands-on practice, techniques, and methods to solve domain-specific problems. A well-rounded design education system entails a meaningful cluster of supportive subjects, enabling the students to build up their theoretical and practical experience in a cumulative manner.



Eligibility

The candidate holding an Intermediate Certificate with a minimum of 50% marks is eligible to apply. Entry tests and interviews are compulsory with 50% passing marks in each category. The merit will be based on the cumulative scores of intermediate, test and interview.



Employability

A versatile experience during this program provides entrepreneurship and employment at the industry level. Sculptors and ceramicists may work in art galleries, as curators for art exhibitions. Some sculptors start their own businesses or form cooperatives with other sculptors. Others may work at government departments and museums as ceramics restorers, advisers in respect of museum displays, or regarding the cleaning and caring of antique collections. They may work at home furnishing stores interior decorating, and manufacturing companies. Moreover, they can work as mentors and researchers.



BS Textile Design

The Textile Design program encourages students to learn innovative ideas and turn them into actual printed, woven, and knitted products. Through our courses, students are trained to blend aesthetic and creative skills with the latest technologies. Students are offered technical courses in weaving, knitting, printing, dyeing & finishing, and materials technology. They also learn a strong technical and conceptual foundation in color theory, drawing, painting, screen printing, weaving, and computer-aided design as well as textile history. Patterns and fabric collections are created for use in apparel and home furnishings. Our qualified faculty focuses on the exhibition of individual creativity for the attainment of a more professional outcome.



Textile Designer, Print designing, Clothing/textile technologist, Color 2021technologist, Digital Designer, Rotary Designer, Textile Graphics Designer, Quality Controller, Textile Market Trend Inspector, Marketing Manager, and Business promoter.



Eligibility

The candidate holding an Intermediate Certificate with a minimum of 50% marks is eligible to apply. Entry tests and interviews are compulsory with 50% passing marks in each category. The merit will be based on the cumulative scores of intermediate, test and interview.

BS Visual Communication Design

Visual Communication Design course is a combination of multiple facets of visual design to provide a strong base for commercial design, packaging, advertising, and marketing knowledge related to traditional, digital, and social media networks. The students would emerge as creative and skilful designers who will be capable of creating designs using various mediums and techniques to meet the needs of all kinds of organizations and institutions. The special focus will be on digital media production, and have an understanding of the consumption of digital media texts and copy writing. The course shall be a combination of various methods including lectures, workshops, seminars, field trips, tutorials, and group discussions using audio-visual aids. They will explore working with diverse media, a variety of output sources, and interactive digital programs. It will produce well equipped visual artists and designers.



Eligibility

The candidate holding an Intermediate Certificate with a minimum of 50% marks is eligible to apply. Entry tests and interviews are compulsory with 50% passing marks in each category. The merit will be based on the cumulative scores of intermediate, test and interview.



Employability

The program is specifically designed to produce professional artists who can work as Art Director, Fine Artist, Multimedia Artist and Animator, Layout Artist, Logo Designer, Professional Photographer, Illustrator and Exhibition Designer. They can work freelance or provide services in the educational field and industry.



BS Applied Psychology

BS Applied Psychology program imparts learning in the principles of applied psychology. The program will provide students with a strong base in the theory, research, and practice of Psychology. Our course will prepare graduates for further training in the field of psychology or a related discipline which can provide evidence-based services for children, adults, and families in a variety of healthcare and educational settings.



Upon completing a professional post-graduate degree students can work in a variety of fields such as in Clinical and Counseling facilities i.e., Hospitals, Private Clinics, Mental Health Institutes, Rehabilitation/Addiction Centers, Guidance and Counseling centers, and Institutions for individuals with special needs. Also, they can go for higher studies in related fields.



Eligibility

The candidate holding an Intermediate Certificate with a minimum of 50% marks is eligible to apply. The merit will be based on intermediate marks. Candidates who have studied Psychology as a subject in intermediate will be given 2 additional marks.



The Digital Media program is a newly designed degree with an aim to meet the needs of the digital media industry in an evolving society. It will impart insight into a wide range of social sciences and prepare them with a foundation that draws on history, theory and practice of media studies, theories for interpretation of diverse forms of technology, communication, and media for dissemination of communication, modern media production and human-computer interaction. Also, advanced critical thinking skills in written analysis of text and visual media objects, understanding the process of working with users in bringing ideas from concept to final production in a digital environment.





The candidate holding an Intermediate Certificate with a minimum of 50% marks is eligible to apply. The merit will be based on intermediate marks.




Employability

Graduates in Digital Media Studies will have career opportunities in the government's public relations department and non-government organizations and the electronic media industry. They can pursue careers as managers, managers, marketers, managers, planners, researchers, teaching, research, and the corporate sector.



BS Gender Studies

BS Gender Studies is designed as an introduction to the interdisciplinary field of Gender Studies and is focused on the ways that sex and gender manifest themselves in social, cultural, and political contexts. Gender Studies is an interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary academic field devoted to various aspects of identity and representation across societies and cultures. With strong foundations in the discipline of Gender Studies and hands-on research and internship experience, students will be able to secure jobs in a variety of careers ranging from the local community to international development organizations and from government organizations to federal bodies.



The diverse and interdisciplinary learning experience of Gender Studies would enable the graduates to be best suitable for positions of women police officers, feminist and gender researchers, community and social welfare officers, public relations officers, social welfare officers, gender specialists, journalists, lecturers, public policy researchers, data analysts, and report writers in the various sector globally.



Eligibility

The candidate holding an Intermediate Certificate with a minimum of 50% marks is eligible to apply. The merit will be based on intermediate marks.

BS Human Development Family Studies

This is a unique academic program for anyone who is intrigued by human nature and holistic human development as well as the factors affecting that development. The subject provides a strong foundation for students seeking a graduate or professional degree in areas such as health sciences, early childhood development, fundamental psychology, family counselling, and preventive intervention.



Eligibility

The candidate holding an Intermediate Certificate with a minimum of 50% marks is eligible to apply. The merit will be based on intermediate marks. Candidates who have studied Psychology as a subject in intermediate will be given 2 additional marks.



Employability

The degree holders can explore and establish their careers in human services as social workers or in the referral services as well as advocacy in national and international organizations. They will also be able to work as Early Childhood professionals. This degree prepares our students for careers such as Preschool/Elementary School Teaching and Educational Administration. They can also work as Child and Adult Counselors/ Developmental Psychologists. They can pursue careers in Human Resources, Public Relations, Research, Training, and Development.



BS Political Science

This degree will focus on learning the fundamentals of political science and allied fields such as diplomacy, public policy, international affairs and communication skills. For this purpose, different streams of specialization in this discipline have been provided to be opted by the students in the last two semesters. The objective of the course is to educate and make students conscious of their rights and obligations towards the state and society.



Political science degree holders can find positions as lobbyists, campaign managers, press secretaries, activists, speech writers, orators, civil rights advocates, mediators, corporate legal counsel, public policy specialists, foreign service officers, and analysts to name a few.



Eligibility

The candidate holding an Intermediate Certificate with a minimum of 50% marks is eligible to apply. The merit will be based on intermediate marks. Candidates who have studied Civics as a subject in intermediate will be given 2 additional marks.

BS Social Entrepreneurship

BS Social Entrepreneurship inspires and equips graduates to demonstrate the ability to devise sustainable social advocacy enterprises focused on solving real-life problems. This is an innovative and fully experiential learning program focusing on project based and problem-based learning. In developing countries like Pakistan, social entrepreneurship is important as it provides individuals, groups and communities with a framework for businesses to find their own success in the pursuit of helping others. Universities have a significant role in creating, developing, and sustaining a rising generation of social entrepreneurs and their ideas. By introducing this discipline, we aim at producing skilled, trained and qualified social entrepreneurs as drivers of change. We also aim to develop a pool of social entrepreneurs who have a pragmatic vision, capable to achieve largescale, systemic and sustainable social change through a different approach. Through this program, we would be able to provide entrepreneurial leaders to different organizations: large and small, new and old nonprofit and for-profit, particularly in Pakistan.



Eligibility

The candidate holding an Intermediate Certificate with a minimum of 50% marks is eligible to apply. The merit will be based on intermediate marks. Candidates who have studied Sociology as a subject in intermediate will be given 2 additional marks.



Employability

Studying Social Entrepreneurship opens a range of careers in areas such as welfare, development sector, human resource management, philanthropy, financial planning and management, resource mobilization and business innovation to name a few.



BS Social Work

BS Social Work degree is a broad-based, interdisciplinary program. Studying social work is a path toward a fulfilling profession; one filled with countless opportunities to impact lives both individually and collectively. The importance of social work lies within its aim to confront social issues in all facets of life from providing oneon-one support of family welfare to shaping legislative policies that eradicate systemic injustices. Social work involves helping others overcome challenges.

Through this program, we aim at encouraging students to critically reflect on their personal and professional practice and to invite them to consider that social work knowledge and practice are socially constructed phenomena. Besides, we also aim at preparing students for social work practice that is sensitive to issues of discrimination and inequity.



Studying Social Work opens a range of careers in areas such as welfare, education, social research, local and central government along with marriage and family counseling, mental health practice, child and family therapy, and education consultancy to name a few.



Eligibility

The candidate holding an Intermediate Certificate with a minimum of 50% marks is eligible to apply. The merit will be based on intermediate marks. Candidates who have studied Sociology as a subject in intermediate will be given 2 additional marks.



BS Sociology is a broad-based interdisciplinary degree, which gives students an insight into a wide range of social science subjects and develops them as a sociologist. This program will enable students to deal with the issues of contemporary social phenomena and prepare them for many wide-ranging career options in diverse fields. It also prepares students for further academic pursuits, particularly in Social Sciences. Following an all-around training in Sociology through this program, students can choose to specialize in a sub-field of their interest at a university in Pakistan or abroad.





The candidate holding an Intermediate Certificate with a minimum of 50% marks is eligible to apply. The merit will be based on intermediate marks. Candidates who have studied Sociology as a subject in intermediate will be given 2 additional marks.



Employability

Studying Sociology opens a range of careers in areas such as welfare, education, social research, and local and central government. Graduates in Sociology have career opportunities in the government's social welfare department, non-government organizations, community development and mobilization programs, police and prison departments, human service programs, teaching, research, and the corporate sector.



BS Human Nutrition Dietetics

BS Human Nutrition & Dietetics program is about food, human body and the connection between diet and health. People of Pakistan are suffering from all types of chronic and acute malnutrition. The long-term and sustainable approach to combat this situation is to prevent and cure diseases with diet management. This degree program will enable students to work in public health awareness and intervention programs and as Registered Clinical Dieticians and Nutritionists. They will develop an understanding of scientific principles, underlying disease conditions, and subsequent dietary modifications. Also, they will be able to examine food production, processing, catering, and distribution complying with legal standards.



The candidates holding F.Sc. (Pre-Medical) / A levels (Biology & Chemistry) / FA Home Economics / equivalent qualification with at least 60% marks is eligible to apply. The merit will be based on intermediate marks.



Employability

Graduates will be able to work as faculty in academia, clinical nutritionists, community nutritionists, nutrition and health experts, nutrition researchers, sports nutritionists, and weight management experts.

BS Public Health Nurtition

This program perceives excellence in Public Health teaching, training and capacity building through provision of broad perspectives of health, nutrition, health-care innovation, critical-thinking and lifelong learning skills into health-care settings. It will strive to acquire methods to propagate knowledge that will be useful for the furthering of Public Health Nutrition Education into Masters and Doctoral program. The graduates of the BSPHN program will be prepared to solve health and nutrition-related problems and conduct, analyze and interpret the results of relevant research surveys and projects within the financial, socio-cultural, environmental, ethical and political framework of Pakistan and its surrounding region.





The candidate holding F.Sc. (Pre-Medical / Pre-Engineering) /A levels (Biology) / DAE (Food & Nutrition Sciences, Human Nutrition and Dietetics, Food Technology) / equivalent qualification with at least 60% marks is eligible to apply. The merit will be based on intermediate marks.



Employability

BSPHN Graduates will be able to serve the community as public health nutrition officer in non-government and government organizations, research associates/ analysts in research and development sector, infection and disease control officer, health promoters in hospitals, health program managers, faculty members in academia, entrepreneurs (public health consultants), public health officers in provincial health ministry, water safety analysts and environment health officers.



BS Food Science Technology

Food technology is the application of a diversity of scientific and practical disciplines including chemistry, biology, physics, and engineering. The discipline comprises food production, processing, preservation, packaging and worldwide distribution. It deals with all types of foods like meat, fruits, vegetables, cereals, fish, eggs, milk, spices, etc. Our mission is to provide high-quality education and training to individuals preparing for careers in food science and technology in government departments, the food industry, academia, research organizations, and official food control laboratories.



Graduates will be qualified to work as food technologists, food and drug inspectors, food scientists, food science technicians, food manufacturing specialists, food product developers, food safety analysts, and food system managers.



Eligibility

The candidate holding F.Sc. (Pre-Medical / Pre-Engineering) / Intermediate (Pre-Agriculture) / equivalent qualification with at least 60% marks is eligible to apply. The merit will be based on intermediate marks.

BS Information Management

BS Information Management is broad-based which gives students insight into a wide range of social and management sciences. Graduates in Information Management learn about managing the knowledge and information in both hard and digital mediums from its production to consumption to archiving and curating. It also provided knowledge about research data management, repositories, and the publishing industry.





The candidate holding an Intermediate Certificate with a minimum of 50% marks is eligible to apply. The merit will be based on intermediate marks.



Employability

The graduates will be able to proceed in their careers as Record Managers in Academia, Archivers, Librarians, cultural heritage institutes, libraries, museums, archives & records centers, media houses, and organization that deals with information in public and private sectors.



BS Home Economics

BS Home Economics equips students with the knowledge and skills needed to be a professional as well as enable them to engage with families and communities for a better-quality life. The students will opt during the last two years for one group of four specialized courses in the following:

Group A Culinary Art Group B Textile & Clothing Group C Child Development Group D Resource and Facility Management



Employability

There are many choices for the students which include 'food service administrators', entrepreneAurs, food and beverage managers and specialists in culinary art. They can be academicians and child life specialists, early childhood education consultants, designers, artists, and social workers to name a few. All these skills are equally beneficial at personal, family and business levels.



Eligibility

The candidate holding Intermediate Certificate with a minimum of 50% marks is eligible to apply. The merit will be based on intermediate marks. Candidates who have studied Home Economics as a subject in intermediate will be given 2 additional marks.

BS Hospitality Tourism Management

Pakistan is at 47th position out of 200 countries as a top tourist destination around the world and has been continuously increasing the number of tourists for the past few years. This latest program aims to prepare students for the fast-growing Hospitality and Tourism industry by providing intense coursework that combines theory with practical learning experiences. Hence, increasing students' opportunities to find employment in management, sales and marketing etc.





The candidate holding an Intermediate Certificate with a minimum of 50% marks is eligible to apply. The merit will be based on intermediate marks.



Employability

The graduates will be able to get jobs in hotels, the aviation industry, restaurants, hostels and so forth. Also, they can be inducted as Tour operators, Travel managers, Holiday Consultants or Event Managers.



BS English Language Literature

This newly developed program aims to make students learn about the English language and literature in an interactive manner to enable them to communicate effectively in written and spoken English language while developing an interest in English literature. It will refine their critical and analytical thinking through literature, history, anthropology etc. Following an interdisciplinary approach, the students will discover how other disciplines enrich their understanding of literary works. One of the course objectives is to introduce the students to the diverse spectrum of majors that would help them to pursue postgraduate studies in the ever-expanding field of language and literature.



Employability

Students with this BS degree can pursue jobs in media and advertising, writing, and publishing, journalism, public relations, content writing and blogging, creative writing, teaching, and academia, among other fields.



Eligibility

The candidate holding an Intermediate Certificate with a minimum of 50% marks is eligible to apply. Entry tests and interviews are compulsory with 50% passing marks in each category. The merit will be based on the cumulative scores of intermediate, test and interview. The candidates who have studeid English Literature as a subject in intermediate will be given 2 additional marks.

ADP Music Studies

The Associate Degree Program of Music Studies is designed to prepare students to demonstrate competence and discipline in the study of music theory, music analysis, music composition, and musicianship skills, and demonstrate proficiency in ensemble skills and solo performance skills. Completion of this curriculum will demonstrate commitment to the serious study of Music in practice and in theory and provide comprehensive preparation for upper division work.

Eligibility

The candidate holding an Intermediate Certificate with a minimum of 50% marks is eligible to apply. The merit will be based on intermediate marks.

ADP Home Economics

The Associate Degree in Home Economics is a two-year degree program. All core, fundamental and general courses related to five major areas of specialization will be taught. This program will help the students to manage personal, family and community resources for better living. The students can take on different professions like teaching, designing, community services and social work.



ADP Hospitality Tourism Management

ADP Program of Hospitality and Tourism Management enables students to analyze the key factors responsible for the growth and development of Hospitality and Tourism, identifying current trends and challenges faced by the Hospitality and Tourism Industry. Tourism is the second largest industry in the world, today plays a very important role in revenue and employment generation. The students can secure jobs in hotels, the aviation industry and restaurants. They can be Tour operators, Travel managers, Holiday Consultants and Event Managers to name a few.

PGD in Dietetics

The discipline of Healthcare Nutrition has grown remarkably over the last few decades. Keeping in view the increasing importance of nutrition in patient care, the Department of Nutrition and Health Promotion, initiated a post-graduate Diploma in Dietetics in 1998 in collaboration with Iowa State University, USA. The success of this diploma has also been contingent on regular revisions to the program over the years. The comprehensive and intensive curriculum will enable students to become competent dietetic professionals and take leading roles in the field of implementing effective nutritional assessment and planning for patients and effectively collaborating with peers, health professionals, and community organizations.



Duration 1 Year



1st Division/70% marks in MSc/BS Home Economics with Majors in Food & Nutrition/Dietetics, BS HND, MBBS or any other relevant/equivalent degree in Nutrition/Dietetics. Candidates will be selected after an interview.



Employability

Students will be able to pursue their careers as consultant dieticians, nutrition researchers, community dieticians, nutrition and health expert, sports nutritionists, weight management experts, and in academia as trainers.

PGD in Speech Language Pathology

The newly offered Post Graduate Diploma in Speech & Language Pathology (PGD-SLP) is a 24-credit hours program that prepares graduates to achieve competence and confidence with clinical/ professional training in speech and language therapy. It focuses on a variety of teaching and learning methods including selfdirected learning. The program will integrate the development of theoretical knowledge with clinical skills across a wide range of client service groups. The program will offer in-depth knowledge for assessment, identification, treatment, support, and care for infants, children, young people, and adults who may have a wide range of speech, language, and communication needs, or difficulties with eating, drinking and swallowing.



Duration 1 Year



Sixteen years of education with a minimum of 2.5 CGPA in Psychology/ Applied Psychology, Behavioral Sciences, Allied Health Sciences, Home Economics with specialization in Human Development & Family Studies/ Child Development or any other relevant qualifications from HEC-recognized universities.



Employability

Upon completion of the program, graduates will be capable of applying theoretical knowledge to the diagnostic, therapeutic, educative, and technical roles of the speech and language therapists within the healthcare, educational and social welfare sectors.

PGD in Counselling

The Post Graduate Diploma in Counselling program provides opportunities for students to develop their knowledge and skills as a counsellor and is especially suited to those considering a career as a practicing counsellor. Counselling is a therapeutic approach with two major strands: firstly, helping people cope with emotional and relational difficulties and, secondly, facilitating personal growth. The program is designed to develop students' theoretical knowledge, therapeutic competency, and culmination as professional counsellors. Students will develop skills in a range of evidencebased counselling modalities; learn to practice within an ethical framework and apply ethical decision-making models to practice; and demonstrate sensitivity to all forms of cultural diversity by providing culturally safe services to a wide range of clients. As a part of the program, students are required to undertake a placement where they need to acquire 100 hours of face-to-face therapeutic work. Supervised clinical training occurs with a diverse client population, presenting a broad range of individual, couple, and family problems in a range of mental health and health care settings.



Duration 1 Year



Sixteen years of education with a minimum of 2.5 CGPA in Psychology/ Applied Psychology, Behavioral Sciences, Allied Health Sciences, Home Economics with specialization in Human Development & Family Studies/ Child Development or any other relevant qualifications from HEC-recognized universities.



Employability

The course equips graduates to work as counsellors in the public, private, and community sectors. The program will offer three specializations including School Counselling, Marriage & Family Counseling as well as Child & Adolescent Counseling. After studying core courses in the first semester, students will choose a specialization of their liking from the three mentioned above. During the 3rd semester, they will be offered field placements in their relevant specializations.

PGD in Early Childhood Education


The Post Graduate Diploma in Early Childhood Education (PGD-ECE) is a program that prepares graduates to achieve competence and confidence in working in the early childhood education sector. It focuses on nurturing participants' professional knowledge, skills and attitudes for incorporation into teaching practice, enabling them to gradually develop into competent early childhood educators and administrators in ECE settings. The program offers a range of coursework combined with field experience encompassing the needs of infants, toddlers, preschoolers, and children in the primary grades. Students are taught to seek evidence-based solutions to problems occurring in child-rearing and education.



Duration 1 Year

Eligibility

Sixteen years of education with a minimum of 2.5 CGPA in any discipline.



Employability

The program seeks to form early childhood educators and specialists (preschool and primary school teachers and administrators, child development consultants, and researchers) who can effectively blend theory and practice in creating positive learning opportunities and experiences for young children to promote their total development.

Diploma in Drawing

Diploma in Traditional Arts



The diploma is specially designed so that the amateurs, as well as the professionals, can learn our traditional arts and crafts, It will engage learners to create concept-based woven fabric designs as well as professional products experimenting with local as well as foreign motifs, and rendering techniques for weaving. It will help the students to create concept-based pottery designs as well as professional products through experimenting. The art of calligraphy is reviving across the world. The program will help the students learn basic scripts.

Diploma in Landscape Design

The landscape design diploma has been designed in consultation with the landscaping industry and teaches the skills that need to succeed quickly and conveniently in this field. The diploma course will guide the basic concepts in landscape design, various landscape categories, and design materials, and the professional scope of landscape design projects. It is a combination of theory and practice. The students will learn landscape as a skill to opt for as a profession. Attempts are made to simulate professional working conditions using "real" locations and requirements. The space is planned according to the region and client requirements.



Diploma in Data Management Curation



In today's digital world, huge amounts of data are produced every minute and it requires better data management solutions. In every business, organization and even educational institution, there is a need to understand the what, where, how, when, and why of data management. Students will investigate data activities that include data entry and design, policies, reuse, repositories, and metadata formation.

Diploma in Data Science

Data is an asset and most companies are far from using it in an effective way. To create value from Big Data, companies need to focus on transforming numbers into meaningful analytics. Data Science is a field that is aligned with the statistical processing of information. This includes statistics, numerical statistics, and machine learning. The program aims to refine students' understanding of how these methods link basic theories that play a considerable role in practice. The students will learn the newest and most used tools in this industry to solve real-life problems.



Diploma in E-Commerce



E-commerce is a continuously flourishing market for products, services, and content through websites, social networks, blogs, videos, music, and games. It is not only a business and technological phenomenon but can also be considered a sociological trend which has changed consumers' buying behaviors. This is a must-have skill as all businesses are shifting to the online model. In addition, there is a need to explore issues associated with e-commerce i.e., security,

authentication, privacy, encryption, legal liabilities, policies, and intellectual rights. This diploma program aims to provide an overview of business and technology, business models, marketing strategies, and social media innovations as it is necessary to successfully sell on the web by using business and marketing strategies.









Instructions for Students

The admissions are open on both Regular (i.e., Open Merit and Reserved Seats) and Self Support programs. Please note that two marks will be deducted for each late year to a maximum of five years.

The students can apply for as many programs/seats, if they meet basic/specific criteria for those programs/ seats. However, they **MUST** submit a separate complete application with the needed/supporting documents and pay separate application processing fee for each program/seat applied for.

The admission form **MUST** be clearly typed/written in block letters.

Incomplete applications in any regard will not be processed for admission.

Age limit is 24 years, however, upto 5 years of age relaxation may be granted to the applicant. For this purpose, the candidate has to request in writing to the Head of Department (HOD) and upon recommendation of the concerned HOD, the form will be forwarded to the **Worthy Vice Chancellor** for final approval.

The merit of BS and Associate Degree Program (ADP) will be based on intermediate result. However, for Faculty of Art & Design and Faculty of History & Languages, the merit will be based on the cumulative scores of intermediate, test and interview.

The envelope **MUST** mention in block letters the name and category of the Program(s) applied for. Categories of the Programs are Open Merit, Reserved Seats and Self Support.
